- C. He won with others.

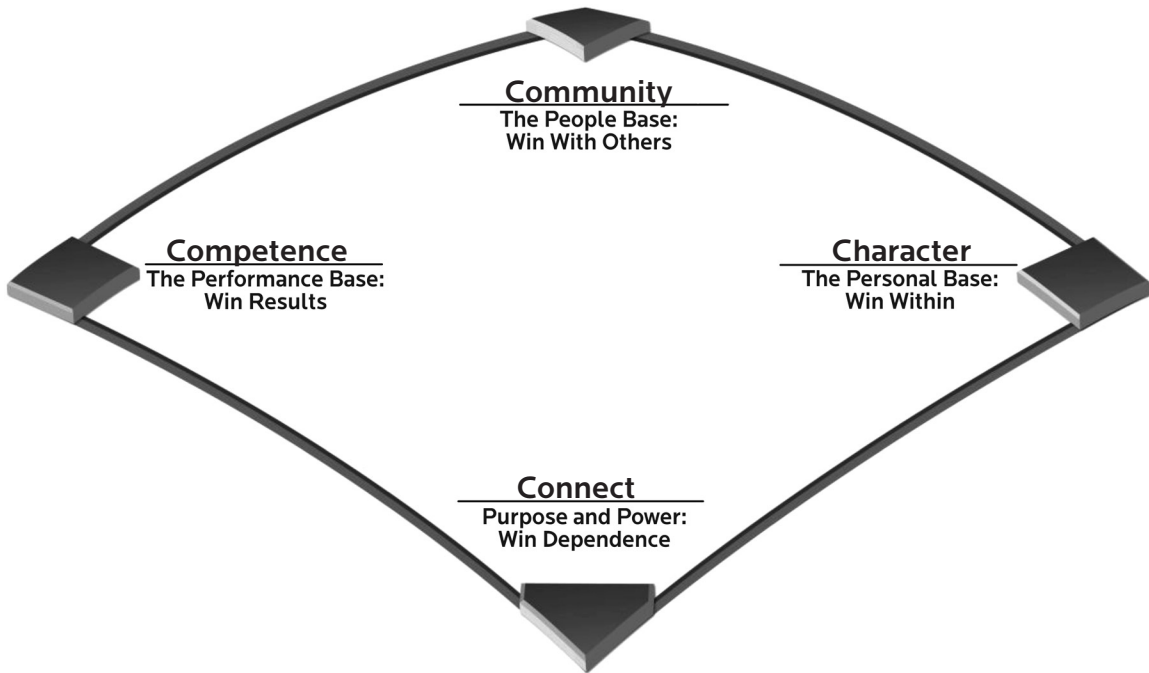
