I. Getting On Base For A Home Run Life (Principle)

A. The power comes through our connection with God.

B. To disconnect from God we disconnect from the power.

II. Three Skills We Need To Develop (Practice)

A. Live for the truth.

“I am the Way, The Truth, and The Life.” John 14:6 (NLT) pg. 752

“Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth.” John 17:17 (NLT) pg. 754

B. Plug into God’s power.

“I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.” John 15:5 (NLT) pg. 752

C. We need to cooperate with God.

“We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin.” Romans 6:6-7 (NLT) pg. 785
